### **KEITH VILLA TO SPEAK TO HISPANIC CHAMBER**

Keith Villa, founder of Blue Moon Brewing Company, will be the keynote speaker at this year's Wichita Hispanic Chamber of Commerce's awards banquet and scholarship program.

The May 16 event, the 11th annual awards and scholarship program, is a partnership between the Hispanic Chamber and the Kansas Hispanic Education & Development Foundation.
